Course Overview

This Lean Six Sigma Awareness Workshop provides a practical overview of the Lean Six Sigma approach. The workshop will provide a basic awareness of the tools and techniques of Lean Six Sigma and will enable the attendees to cut through the Lean Six Sigma jargon and understand what Lean Six Sigma can deliver for their organisation.

The workshop is structured around a role play simulation, during which participants have an opportunity to use Lean Six Sigma techniques to analyse and improve a process in the training environment.

Who should attend?

This workshop is aimed at participants who are new to Lean Six Sigma, and who wish to gain a rapid overview of the subject. Participants do not require any previous knowledge of Lean Six Sigma or improvement techniques. Typical attendees include:

- Senior managers who require a rapid overview of the subject matter
- Six Sigma project sponsors
- Prospective Green or Black Belts, considering further in-depth training.
- Employees requiring an understanding of Six Sigma in order to actively participate in Six Sigma project teams.
